


15 8. Further, on or about October 2, 1997, I applied in

2 did not want my permit to lapse prior to renewal.

16 renewal on April 18, 1997.


17 8. On or about February 6, 1998, I was informed that the

23 same and as it was upon issuance and renewal.

24 9. As of this date, I have not received renewal of my
25 permit and that permit has expired.

26 10. On or about February 10, 1998, I personally appeared at
27 the front desk of the Los Angeles Police Department, Van Nuys
28 Station, located at 6240 Sylmar Avenue, Van Nuys, California. I

1 explained to the officer in charge that I wanted to apply for a
2 renewal of my Concealed Carry Permit and that I needed the
3 application for a concealed carry firearm permit to do so and that
4 I also wanted any guidelines and other informative information
5 related to such. Filed herewith as Exhibit "7", contained in the
6 Exhibits in Support of OSC Re Contempt, and fully incorporated
7 herein by reference is a true and accurate copy of the Application
8 to Carry a Concealed Firearm that was provided to me, at the
