

1 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

2 **The following case is related to this action:** *David R. Davis, et al. v. City of Los Angeles,*
3 *et al.*, Los Angeles County Superior Court Case No. BS131915. The *Davis* case is related to the
4 above-captioned matter because both involve the same Defendants, and are based on the same or
5 similar allegations that Defendants have failed to follow the court-ordered procedure for
6 consideration of concealed carry weapons (“CCW”) permits previously entered in this action.

7 Like the Plaintiffs in *Assenza*, plaintiffs in the *Davis* action are residents of Los Angeles
8 who sought to apply for a CCW permit, and were either denied an application, or, after filling out
9 an application, were denied a CCW permit due to Defendants’ failure to adhere to the procedure
10 agreed-to by Defendants and ordered in this action. Thus, these cases arise from the same or
11 substantially identical transactions, incidents or events requiring the determination of the same or
12 substantially identical questions of law or fact.

13 The above-captioned case was filed on November 4, 2004 and was last heard in
14 Department 14 by the Honorable Terry A. Green when the Third Amended Judgment of
15 Declaratory Relief was entered on June 11, 2011.

16 *David R. Davis, et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al.* was filed on May 18, 2011 and is
17 assigned to the Honorable James C. Chalfant in Department 85.

18 Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations § 3.300(a), these cases likely to require
19 “substantial duplication of judicial resources if heard by different judges.”
