The Brady Center to Prevent Gun Violence (Brady Center) seeks
leave to file a brief as amicus curiae in opposition to
Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment and in support of
Defendants' cross-motion for summary judgment in the instant case.

Having considered its papers, the Court DENIES the Brady
Center's motion as untimely. Briefing is already underway on the
parties' cross-motions. If the Court were to grant the Brady
Center's motion, it would need to change the briefing and hearing
schedule on the cross-motions to allow Plaintiff a fair
opportunity to respond fully to the Brady Center's brief, in
addition to those submitted by Defendants and the other amicus,
Legal Community Against Violence (LCAV). Thus, the Court declines
to grant the Brady Center amicus status at this late stage. The
