ORDER REQUESTING SUPPLEMENTAL
BRIEFING REGARDING THE
DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR REVIEW OF
MAGISTRATE ZAREFSKY'S DISCOVERY
ORDER

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1 This matter comes before the Court on the following motions:
2 On August 30, 2006, the defendants filed a motion for review of
3 Magistrate Zarefsky's discovery order in this case. On September
4 18, 2006, the plaintiffs filed a motion for summary adjudication,
5 and the defendants filed motions for summary judgment. On the
6 Court's own order, the hearing on these motions was moved to
7 Monday, December 18, 2006.

8 Upon reviewing the parties' papers on the defendant's motion
9 for review, the Court cannot determine which, if any, of the
10 discovery disputes outlined in those papers have now been resolved.
11 Before the Court can rule on the pending motions, it must know the
12 status of these disputes. Accordingly, the Court orders the
13 parties to file supplemental briefing regarding what discovery
14 disputes remain in this case and what affect those discovery
15 disputes will have on the pending motions for summary judgment.
16 The supplemental briefs should not exceed 15 pages in length, and
17 must be filed by Monday, January 22, 2007. Should the parties wish
18 to file oppositions to the supplemental briefs, those oppositions
19 will be due on Monday, January 27, 2007. Any replies will be due
20 on Monday, February 5, 2007.

21 After reviewing the supplemental briefing, the Court will
22 determine whether it would be appropriate to entertain the parties'
23 motions for summary judgment as they currently stand. Therefore,
24 the Court hereby moves the hearing date on the defendants' motions
25 for summary judgment and the plaintiffs' motion for summary
26 adjudication from Monday, December 18, 2006, at 10:00 a.m., to
27 Monday, February 26, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. The Court will also

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1 address the defendant's motion for review and the supplemental
2 briefing on the motion during the hearing on February 19th.

3 The final pre-trial conference in this case is moved from
4 Monday, January 29, 2007, at 4:00 p.m., to Monday, April 9, 2007,
5 at 4:00 p.m. The trial date is moved from Tuesday, February 27,
6 2007, at 9:00 a.m., to Tuesday, April 17, 2007, at 9:00 a.m.


