18 The parties by and through their respective counsel hereby stipulate to continue the
19 settlement conference set for Wednesday, January 10, 2007.

20 The Court has continued the hearing on the parties' cross motions for summary
21 judgment from December 18, to February 26, 2007. As was the case last time around, in
22 order to have a productive settlement conference, the parties would like to have it occur
23 after the summary judgment hearing.

24 The Court may recall that defendants have indicated that they are unable to make
25 any kind of settlement offer until they receive a ruling on the summary judgment motions.
26 In addition, it is still terribly difficult for plaintiffs to come to court, especially for Mrs.
27 Millender, who suffers from high blood pressure and uses a walker, and sometimes a
28 wheelchair.


