- 7 information and a brief statement of the nature of their expected testimony. Any witness identified on the list who was not formally identified before the discovery deadline on May 31, 2002, can be

- 10 June 14, 2002 First exchange of expert witness information pursuant to C.C.P. §
- 11 2034. For those experts who will create or rely on statistical or

- 14 media to allow the opposing party to run, replicate or otherwise
- 15 interpret the model or database, together with all codes, data or other
