SCHEDULING ORDER

WHEREAS, plaintiffs in this matter having filed a Motion for Preliminary Injunction on June 26, 2013 (ECF Doc. # 14) (“plaintiffs’ motion”), and counsel for the parties having conferred with each other regarding the briefing of plaintiffs’ motion, and the Court having held a teleconference with counsel for all parties on Monday, July 1, 2013 to discuss the briefing of the plaintiffs’ motion, the following briefing schedule is established:

- (1) All amicus briefs in support of plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction are to be filed with the Court by no later than Friday, July 12, 2013. All amicus briefs in opposition to plaintiffs’ motion for Preliminary Injunction shall be filed with the Court no later than seven days after defendants file their opposition to plaintiffs motion for preliminary injunction.
- (2) The defendants are to file their opposition to plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction by no later than Friday, September 6, 2013.
- (3) The plaintiffs are to file their reply to defendants’ opposition to their motion for preliminary injunction by no later than Monday, October 7, 2013.
- (4) Plaintiffs have requested oral argument on their motion for preliminary injunction. The defendants take no position on the plaintiffs’ request. At the conclusion of all briefing on plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction, the parties shall confer to determine whether an evidentiary hearing is necessary.
