DECLARATION OF WILSON LOBAO

- I, Wilson Lobao, declare as follows:
- 1. I reside in Peabody, Massachusetts and am 72 years of age. I am married, have 10 grown children, and am retired. I have been trained as a range officer. I am competent to testify on my own behalf.
- 2. I applied for a license to carry firearms ("LTC") in November 2008 from the Peabody Police Department.
- 3. When I contacted the Police Department to apply for my LTC, the Police Department provided me with an application form and instructions. I completed the application form and returned both it and other items of required documentation (such as identification and documentation of firearms safety training) to the Police Department. A copy of the paper

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application form that I filled out and submitted is attached as Exhibit 1. As indicated on the application form, I requested the issuance of a Class A LTC. I filled out the section of the form that requested "Reason(s) for requesting the issuance of a card or license" with, "carry to and from home to club range and boat – self protection."

- 4. Pursuant to the instructions that I received from the Police Department, I also submitted a letter setting forth my specific reasons for requesting a Class A LTC without restrictions with my application. I was told that I would only be issued a Class B LTC unless I submitted this letter. This letter is attached as Exhibit 2. As indicated in my letter, the specific reasons I stated were that I wanted to be able to transport "large capacity" rifles to the Haverhill Hound Rod and Gun Club, where I am a member, and that I wanted to be able to carry a handgun for protection while traveling to, from, and on my boat.
- 5. On December 5, 2008 the Peabody Police Department issued me a Class B LTC with the annotation, "Restrictions: Target & Hunting". A copy of this LTC is attached as Exhibit 3.
- 6. The Peabody Police Department did not provide me with any guidance regarding what activities this "Target & Hunting" restriction did or did not allow.
- 7. After I received my LTC, I contacted the detective who handled gun licensing issues at the time. He told me that I could wait and re-apply, but that the chief of police did not like to issue LTC's.
- 8. I would carry a handgun for protection but for my fear that I would be charged with violating my LTC restriction and that my LTC might be suspended or revoked.

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I affirm all of the foregoing statements under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America.

This letter is in reply to your requirement of reasons for requesting a License to Carry Firearms, Class A

As a Member of the Haverhill Hound Rod and Gun Club, the opportunity presents itself to join the pistol and rifle teams. The rifles used are of the Military type, large capacity; which requires a Class A License to transport in my vehicle. I cannot even own legally, an eleven shot clip for the twenty-two caliber rifle, which I own.

I would also like the option of being able to carry a pistol to and on my boat without anyone knowing there is one on board. There are something's best not advertised. There are occasions when we sail to remote areas, with expensive equipment on board. Not that having a weapon on board is the total answer; it does provide another option for self-defense.

My preference is for the Class A License; primarily, my belief of out of sight, out of mind. The Idea of carrying anything in a lockable case only suggests something of value, and possibly worth stealing; even without knowing what's in it; also more awkward to carry and handle.
