The grand jury charges:

Count 1

On or about April 15, 2010, within the Southern District of California, defendant DANIEL EDWARD CHOVAN, who had been previously convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence, that is: Inflicting Corporal Injury on a Spouse, in violation of California Penal Code Section 273.5(a), case number CE172918, in the County of San Diego on April 15, 1996, did knowingly possess firearms in and affecting interstate or foreign commerce, to wit:
