The motion to dismiss the Third Amended Complaint of Defendants Attorney General Xavier Becerra and Bureau of Firearms Director Martin Horan, filed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6), came on for hearing in this Court on February 19, 2019, at 1:30 p.m., in Courtroom 5, before the Honorable William B. Shubb, United States District Judge. George Lee appeared on behalf of Plaintiffs. Deputy Attorney General John D. Echeverria appeared on behalf of Defendants.

Having considered Defendants' motion and Plaintiffs' opposition, the other pleadings and documents on file in this case, and the arguments of the parties, the Court finds that Plaintiffs' Third Amended Complaint fails to state a claim as a matter of law and that Plaintiffs cannot cure these defects by amendment. Accordingly, the Court hereby GRANTS Defendants' motion
without leave to amend, dismisses this action with prejudice, and enters final judgment for Defendants and against Plaintiffs.
