21 DECLARATION OF JEREMIAH MORRIS

23 I, Jeremiah Morris, declare as follows:

24 1. I am an adult resident of the County of Kern, California, and a named plaintiff in
25 this matter. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this declaration, and if called as a
26 witness, could competently testify thereto. This declaration is executed in support of Plaintiffs'
27 Motion for Summary Judgment.

1 2. I am not prohibited from possessing or acquiring firearms under State or federal
2 law.

3 3. I am a member of organization plaintiffs California Gun Rights Foundation
4 (formerly named “The Calguns Foundation”), Firearms Policy Coalition, FPC Action Foundation
5 (formerly named “Firearms Policy Foundation”), and Second Amendment Foundation.

6 4. Prior to the year 2000, I lawfully acquired standard firearm magazines capable of
7 holding over ten rounds (cartridges) of ammunition that the State bans as “large-capacity”
8 magazines.

9 5. In addition to maintaining possession of the “large-capacity” magazines that I
10 already own and possess, I desire and intend to acquire more magazines capable of holding more
11 than ten rounds of ammunition, and would, but for the State’s laws challenged in this case and its
12 enforcement of them.

13 6. Removing from the State or selling the magazines already in my possession
14 outside of the State would adversely affect my right to keep and bear arms for self-defense and
15 other lawful purposes.

16 7. As an ordinary, peaceable citizen, I do not qualify for any exception to the State’s
17 prohibition on the possession of “large-capacity” magazines.

18 8. Unless the enforcement of the State’s “large-capacity” magazine ban laws is
19 declared unconstitutional and enjoined, I will suffer a physical deprivation of property that is
20 both independently valuable and a necessary part of a functional firearm.

21 I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed on
