 21 22 23 24 25 	DECLARATION OF WILLIAM WIESE I, William Wiese, declare as follows: 1. I am an adult resident of the City of San Jose, California, and a named plaintiff in this matter. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this declaration, and if called as a	
25 26	witness, could competently testify thereto. This declaration is executed in support of Plaintiffs'	
27	Motion for Summary Judgment.	
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2. I am not prohibited from possessing or acquiring firearms under State or federal law.

3 3. I am a board member and supporter of organization plaintiff California Gun
4 Rights Foundation (formerly named "The Calguns Foundation"), and I am a member and
5 supporter of Firearms Policy Coalition, FPC Action Foundation (formerly named "Firearms
6 Policy Foundation"), and Second Amendment Foundation.

4. Prior to the year 2000, I lawfully acquired standard firearm magazines capable of holding over ten rounds (cartridges) of ammunition that the State bans as "large-capacity" magazines.

5. In addition to maintaining possession of the "large-capacity" magazines that I already own and possess, I desire and intend to acquire more magazines capable of holding more than ten rounds of ammunition, and would, but for the State's laws challenged in this case and its enforcement of them.

6. Removing from the State or selling the magazines already in my possession outside of the State would adversely affect my right to keep and bear arms for self-defense and other lawful purposes.

7. As an ordinary, peaceable citizen, I do not qualify for any exception to the State's prohibition on the possession of "large-capacity" magazines.

8. Unless the enforcement of the State's "large-capacity" magazine ban laws is declared unconstitutional and enjoined, I will suffer a physical deprivation of property that is both independently valuable and a necessary part of a functional firearm.
