3 Whereas on June 12, 2006, an Order having been entered in this action finding and adjudging
4 that Proposition H or Ordinance No. 55-06, which was enacted on November 8, 2005 and which
5 appears in Article 36A, Sections 3600A and 3601A of the San Francisco Police Code, is invalid as
6 preempted by state law and ordering that a peremptory writ of mandamus be issued from this court;

7 NOW THEREFOR YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED immediately on receipt of this writ
8 not to enforce Proposition H or Ordinance No. 55-06, which was enacted on November 8, 2005 and
9 which appears in Article 36A, Sections 3600A and 3601A of the San Francisco Police Code.

10 Petitioner shall recover costs in this proceeding, per costs memo.

11 This Court's jurisdiction over determining Petitioners' entitlement to recover attorneys' fees,
12 and if so what amount, shall be retained. Entitlement to and the appropriate amount of attorney's fees
13 will be determined on noticed motion to be submitted to the Court by Petitioners within 60 days after
14 this judgment becomes final and non-appealable or within 60 days after remittitur from the Court of
15 Appeals.
