I have been a law enforcement officer since 1981, and am a graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy. I was originally elected Sheriff of Tehama County in 1998 and have been reelected to 5 that position three times. I am the immediate-past President of the California State Sheriffs' 6 Association, and am a former President of the Western States' Sheriffs' Association. 7 2. I am responsible for enforcing federal, state, and local laws within the County of 8 Tehama, including Penal Code sections 12060, 12061, and 12318. 9 10 3. I am responsible for determining the policies of the Tehama County Sheriff's office, including a determination of what ammunition is regulated as "handgun ammunition" under 11 California Penal Code sections 12060, 12061, and 12318. 12 4. I do not know what types of ammunition are principally for use in a handgun. 13 5. Without any further guidelines as to what types of ammunition are "handgun 14 ammunition" under Penal Code sections 12060, 12061, and 12318, I am unable to enforce these laws because I do not know what types of ammunition are "handgun ammunition." 16 6. I do not know whether the principally for use in a handgun standard means that a 17 particular type of ammunition will be considered "handgun ammunition" under California Penal 18 Code sections 12060, 12061, and 12318 if that caliber is used more often in a handgun than in a 19 20 rifle. 21 7.
