WHEREAS, both Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment and 1 Defendants' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment are set to be heard before the 2 Honorable Chief Judge Irma Gonzalez on November 15, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in 3 Courtroom 1, or as soon thereafter as may be heard by the court; 4 WHEREAS, the hearing before Chief Judge Gonzalez on the parties' cross-5 motions may dispose of or alter one or more of Plaintiffs' claims, and therefore 6 change the scope of, or even possibly eliminate potential discovery requests for 7 both parties; 8 WHEREAS, the parties wish to avoid costly discovery that may be 9 unnecessary or insufficient, depending on the disposition of the parties cross-10 motions; 11 WHEREAS, all parties believe this Court's Order of August 6, 2010 should 12 be vacated, and a new Fed. R. Civ.
