The motion as to the second cause of action brought by Gloria Molina, Zev Yaroslavsky and Yvonne Brathwaite Burke, Supervisors of Los Angeles County on behalf of the general public is denied.

The motion as to the cause of action for violation of Bus. and Prof. Code Sec. 17500, et seq., brought by the County of Los Angeles is granted with 21 days leave to amend for Plaintiff to clarify that the claim is being pursued by the County of Los Angeles, by and through the Los Angeles County Counsel.

As to Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC210894,

The motion as to the Cities of Compton, Inglewood and West Hollywood's claim for violation of Bus. and Prof. Code Sec. 17200, et seq., is granted with 21 days leave to amend for Plaintiffs to plead that they have obtained the consent of the appropriate District Attorney to bring this action.

The motion as to the claim for violation of Sec. 17200 brought by the general public by and through Legrand H. Clegg II, City Attorney of the City of Compton, Roosevelt Dorn, Mayor of the City of Inglewood and John Heilman, Mayor of the City of West Hollywood is denied.

The motion as to both actions challenging certain Plaintiffs' standing to seek civil penalties is denied as the Court concludes this issue would have been more appropriately raised as a motion to strike.

Where the Court has granted the motion it has permitted Plaintiffs leave to amend. Because the issues raised by the motion concern technical pleading allegations, any amendment filed by Plaintiffs will not change the substantive allegations that have been on file for over three years. Accordingly, to the extent Plaintiffs file amended complaints all appearing Defendants' earlier answers are deemed the answers to the amended complaints and neither demurrers nor motions to strike, including those pursuant to Calif. Code of Civ. Proc. Sec. 425.16, will be entertained. Similarly, the Court leaves on calendar all pending motions for summary judgment and/or adjudication.
