Dear Ms. Dwyer:

On September 13, 2010, Appellants in the above entitled case filed a Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 28(j) letter brief regarding the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals' recent decision in the matter of Anderson v. Hermosa Beach, No. 08-56914 (September 9, 2010). The Court of Appeals holding in Anderson is not relevant to the issues before this Court in this case for the following reasons:

Central to the holding in Anderson is the fact that the ordinance at issue effectively banned tattoo parlors throughout the City of Hermosa Beach. In contrast, the Ordinance before this Court is not a County-wide ban on gun possession. The Ordinance regulates gun possession only on certain County-owned property, as defined in the Ordinance, and does not regulate gun possession throughout the unincorporated County territory. Even assuming arguendo the Ordinance precludes Appellants from conducting a gun show on the Fairgrounds in the manner they wish to conduct a gun show, the Record reflects that gun shows continue to take place elsewhere in Alameda County. Excerpts of Record in Appeal No. 07-15763, Vol. II, pp. 420-431.

As the Record before this Court also reflects, the Scottish Games historical reenactments are conducted on the Fairgrounds consistent with the safety requirements of the exception to the Ordinance set forth at

Section 9.12.120(f)(4). Excerpts of Record in Appeal No. 07-15763, Vol. II, p. 395, lines 16-25. That exception is available to Appellants. Accordingly, the statement in Appellants' Rule 28(j) letter that the County "permits the Scottish Games to display their guns, but denies that same right to Appellants" is incorrect.
