IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that for the reasons stated in the Court's memorandum opinion dated 06/19/12, Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment [40] is granted and the court finds that Section (b)(3)(iii) of the Chicago Firearm Ordinance is unconstitutionally void for vagueness and is unconstitutional for violating Plaintiff's Second Amendment constitutional right to keep and bear arms. As to Plaintiff's request for injunctive relief, the City of Chicago is barred from denying Plaintiff's application for a Chicago Firearm Permit based upon his misdemeanor conviction that is the subject of this action. In light of this court's holding that Section (b)(3)(iii) of the Chicago Firearm Ordinance is unconstitutional under the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution, Plaintiff's claims in Counts I and III are stricken as moot.
