Status hearing held and continued to 04/18/12 at 9:00 a.m. As stated on the record, Plaintiff's motion for judgment on the pleadings [26] is denied to the extent that Plaintiff seeks administrative review of the decision by DOAH and the Court will state its reasons when ruling on dispositive motions. As to the constitutionality of the ordinance and as to the application to Plaintiff, the motion is stricken without prejudice in order to give the parties and opportunity to complete discovery. Discovery on constitutionality issues shall be completed by 01/20/12. The parties are to submit within the next 30 days, a joint memorandum as to Plaintiff's conviction at issue. Dispositive motions are to be filed by 02/17/12. Answers to dispositive motions are to be filed by 03/02/12 and replies are to be filed by 03/09/12.
