

## OVERVIEW

Education Code Section 48926 requires county superintendents to submit a plan to The Superintendent of Public Instruction, no later than June 30, 1997, regarding the provision of educational services to all expelled students in the county. Section 48926 further provides that each county superintendent of schools, in conjunction with district superintendents in the county, shall submit to the Superintendent of Public Instruction a triennial update to that plan. The following plan is the required triennial update due June 30, 2006.

The four elementary school districts, one high school district and the four unified school districts of Glenn County provide services to 5,977 students at seventeen traditional school sites, and eighteen alternative school sites. Due to the rural nature and the relatively small size of each school district in Glenn County, the County Office of Education along with the nine school districts formulated a plan for the education of expelled students, which is discussed in this document.

California Education Code Section 48916.1 states, "At the time an expulsion of a pupil is ordered, the governing board of the school district shall ensure that an educational program is provided to the pupil who is subject to the expulsion order for the period of the expulsion..." Glenn County School Districts may refer expelled students to their Community Day Schools or to another district's Community Day School by contractual agreement.

California Education Code Section 48926 also states, "The plan shall be adopted by the governing board of each school district within the county and by the county board of education." A countywide plan was designed and adopted by all school districts and the County Office of Education in 1997. The Updated Plans were completed in June of 2003, and May 2006.

The approval of the Glenn County Board of Education and the submission of this plan to the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall satisfy requirements associated with the "county plan for provision of educational services to expelled students." In addition, this plan shall be distributed to every district superintendent in Glenn County and updated prior to June 30, 2006, as required by law.
