NOTICE OF EXPULSION HEARING

RE: GARY TUDESKO
Willows High School, Grade 11

Dear Ms. Parisio:

Mort Geivett, Principal, Willows High School, has referred your son Gary Tudesko ("Gary/Student") for an expulsion hearing to the District's Governing Board with a recommendation for expulsion based on the following:

Specific Charge: Education Code, Section 48900:

- (b) Possessed, sold, or otherwise furnished a firearm, knife, explosive, or other dangerous object.

Specific Charge: Education Code, Section 48915:

- (c)(1) Possessing, selling, or otherwise furnishing a firearm.

Specific Facts Substantiating Charge(s):

The Administration of the Willows High School is recommending that Gary Tudesko, an eleventh grade student be expelled. Presently, the student has had his suspension extended pending the expulsion hearing. The High School is recommending the expulsion hearing for the following reasons: On October 26, 2009 at 9:15 AM, Mort Geivett, Principal, Willows High School was informed that during a routine sweep of the campus parking areas, the Interquest canine alerted on



Gary's truck, which was parked behind the school tennis courts. Officer Alves, Willows Police Department and District School Resource Officer were summoned to the school office, and as Gary's truck was searched, ammunition and two shotguns were found within the vehicle. Gary was informed that this was a violation of the Education Code, Section 48900, subdivision, (b). Gary was initially suspended for five days and later his suspension was extended pending the expulsion hearing itself.

This is a serious matter and may ultimately result in Gary's expulsion from the school district.


As you are aware, Dr. Steve Olmos, Superintendent, has discussed these charges with you. The District's expulsion hearing is scheduled for Thursday, November 19, 2009 at 1:00 PM at the Willows City Hall, in the City Chamber, located at 201 North Lassen Street, Willows, California, 95988. The District's Governing Board will conduct the expulsion hearing in this matter and will function under the guidelines stipulated pursuant to Section 48918 of the Education Code. You are requested to attend the hearing with your child to discuss the matter with us. After considering the information presented, the Governing Board will make a final order regarding whether your child will be expelled.

Please note, you and your child have the following procedural rights with regard to an expulsion hearing with the Board:

1. You have the right to appear in person at the hearing and to employ and be represented by counsel or other persons who may be present. You may also be represented by a non attorney advisor.
2. You have the right to see copies of all documents to be used at the hearing and to obtain them in advance of the hearing by making a written request of the District's administration.
3. You have the right to ask pertinent questions of witnesses. Any witness may be requested to appear voluntarily at the hearing on the student's behalf. Subpoenas for personal appearance at the hearing may be issued for percipient witnesses only.
4. You have the right to question all evidence presented and present your version to the Governing Board.
5. You have the right to present verbal and documentary evidence on behalf of your student.
6. You have the right to request a postponement of the hearing, which shall not exceed 30 calendar days. Your request must be submitted in writing prior to the scheduled hearing.
7. The hearing will be held in a session closed to the public unless you request, in writing, at least five days prior to the date of the hearing that the hearing be conducted in public session.
8. Technical rules of evidence shall not apply at the hearing.
9. Pursuant to Education Code section 48915.1, an expelled student or parent/guardian is obligated to inform any new district, in which the student seeks to enroll, of the student's status with the expelling district.

Please contact me with any questions or concerns. We look forward to reaching a final resolution in this matter soon.

SECTION 2:

EXPECTED STUDENT BEHAVIOR AND DISCIPLINE POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

PURPOSE OF STUDENT DISCIPLINE AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

Rules and regulations are established for maintaining an atmosphere that is conducive to learning and to a campus that is safe for all students and staff. Students who do not comply with such rules and regulations may be counseled, reprimanded, suspended, or, in extreme cases, expelled and/or arrested when violations of the law have occurred.

Participation or attendance at extracurricular activities is considered a part of the educational program. Participants and spectators carry responsibilities as representatives of their schools and communities. All rules of student conduct also apply to student activities during or after regular school hours whether on or off campus.

BASIC STUDENT BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

In order for each student to get the maximum benefit from the educational program at Willows High School, it is necessary and important that everyone observe the following;

- **Attend your assigned classes and be on time each day;**
- **Do all the assignments required by the teacher;**
- **Respect the rights of other people, which include fellow students, teachers, guests of the school, and other employees of the school district.**

All students shall be held accountable for their behavior/actions if they choose to violate any of these basic expectations.

We have found it necessary to suspend your student for violating these Education Code sections:

Ed Code Section	Violation
48900	Firearm, Possession of (E) 48900 (b)
48900	Weapon, Possession of (E) 48900 (b)

The incident that caused this suspension happened as follows:

During a routine sweep of the campus and parking areas, the Interquest canine focused on Gary's truck parked behind the tennis courts. Gary's truck was searched, and ammunition and two shotguns were found in the vehicle.

Your child has been suspended for 5 days and makes a total of 6 this year.
The first day of suspension is 10/26/2009. The first day back at school will be 11/2/2009.

During this suspension, the student is expected to remain at home under adult supervision and may not attend school activities or be on or around the school campus. Students may be allowed to make up the work missed during the suspension at the discretion of the teacher, as provided in the education code. I have been informed that I am prohibited from returning to any campus or school owned property located within the District Office during school or non-school hours, and on school and non-school days. This also includes school activities. My signature also indicates that I have been informed that it is a violation of the terms of my suspension to loiter on public streets without adult supervision during regular school hours (7:30 am to 2:30 pm). I understand that failure to abide by these rules is a violation of law which can be punished by arrest and/or incarceration in the County Juvenile Hall or other appropriate law enforcement facility (California Penal Code, Sections 626.2, 626.4, and 653-g). These prohibitions will remain in effect until the District Office permits my return to a school within the District.

This student does not receive Special Education services.

The administration of Willows High School is recommending that Gary Tudesko, an eleventh grade student, be expelled. Presently, the student has been suspended for five school days until 8:00 A.M. on November 2, 2009. A parent contact was made by Mr. Geivett on Monday, October 26, 2009.

We are recommending that the suspension be continued beyond the above date and time pending an expulsion hearing. This recommendation is based on past precedence in situations such as this within the Willows Unified School District.

On October 26, 2009 at approx. 9:15 AM, Mr. Geivett was informed that during a routine sweep of the campus and parking areas, the Interquest canine alerted on Gary Tudesko's truck, which was parked behind the school tennis courts. Officer Alves (WPD) was summoned to the school office, and as Gary's truck was searched, ammunition and two shotguns were found within the vehicle. Gary was informed that this was a violation of Education code 48900 (b) "Possession of a Firearm", which results in a suspension and an expulsion recommendation.

Gary was suspended for the five days (pending expulsion) based on Ed. Code §48900 (b) "Possessed, sold or otherwise furnished any firearm or other dangerous object"

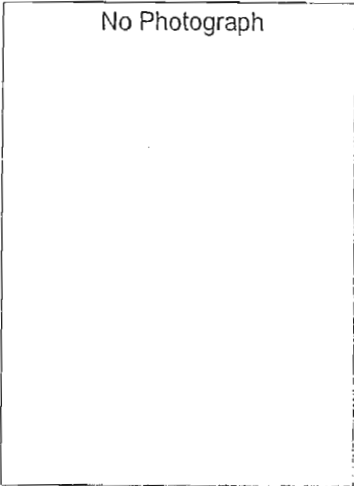



DRESS STANDARDS WHILE ATTENDING SCHOOL

School dress need not be a major issue in a student's education. The parents should be as concerned as the school staff in the fact that the student's dress reflects his/her pride in school and his/her family. The school environment is part of their preparation for the future, so we have traditionally maintained that a student comes to school in much the same dress he/she is expected to wear in a typical business environment. The following ARE EXAMPLES OF INAPPROPRIATE DRESS and ARE NOT TO BE WORN AT SCHOOL: *Short shorts or miniskirts; pants worn below the waistline; undergarments showing; clothing exposing midriff area, tube tops, tops exposing cleavage, and backless tops; unapproved costumes; T-shirts or other clothing or any jewelry with vulgar words, pictures, or phrases that promote sex, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, gang activity or advocate violence; shoeless; dirty or wet clothing; T-shirts that are not outer wear quality. Hats must be worn with the bill forward.*

If it is determined that the student is wearing inappropriate clothing, he/she will be required to change into the appropriate clothing. If a student is asked to change their clothing, call home for assistance, or require time away from class to change, the time missed will be recorded as an unexcused absence for the time missed. The decision concerning appropriateness of dress remains with the administration. Repeat offenders will be considered to be in defiance of authority and the appropriate penalty shall be imposed.

Regardless of color, any article of clothing displaying gang colors, or affiliation in any manner, is prohibited.

ELECTRONIC SIGNALING DEVICES

"No school shall permit the possession or use of any electronic signaling device that operates through the transmission or receipt of radio waves, including, but not limited to cell phones and paging or signaling devices by pupils of the school while the pupils are on campus, while attending school-sponsored activities, or while under the supervision and control of school district employees, without the prior consent of the school administration." (E.C. 48901.5). School administration allows cell phones on the WHS campus, but they may only be used during passing periods (including lunch).

EXPLOSIVE DEVICES

Firecrackers, palmettos, dynamite caps, munitions, and any other type of explosive devices are illegal to possess on school property. Possession shall result in confiscation, police contact, and suspension from school with a mandatory expulsion hearing.

FALSE ALARMS

Sounding a false fire alarm, tampering with or destroying fire protection equipment is a misdemeanor. Violators will be referred to the proper authorities and the appropriate consequences will be imposed detention, work detail, suspension, etc.

(3)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph (B), it shall be unlawful for any person, knowingly or with reckless disregard for the safety of another, to discharge or attempt to discharge a firearm that has moved in or that otherwise affects interstate or foreign commerce at a place that the person knows is a school zone.

(B) Subparagraph (A) does not apply to the discharge of a firearm—

- (i) on private property not part of school grounds;
 - (ii) as part of a program approved by a school in the school zone, by an individual who is participating in the program;
 - (iii) by an individual in accordance with a contract entered into between a school in a school zone and the individual or an employer of the individual; or
 - (iv) by a law enforcement officer acting in his or her official capacity.
- (4) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as preempting or preventing a State or local government from enacting a statute establishing gun free school zones as provided in this subsection.

General Information

Generally, it is unlawful for any individual to knowingly possess a firearm within a school zone. A school zone is defined as being within a distance of 1,000 feet from the grounds of a public, parochial, or private school. This prohibition does not apply to the possession of a firearm on private property not part of school grounds such as an FFL's business premise (e.g., commercial storefront, residence, or driveway).

Once a customer leaves private property located within 1,000 feet of a school with a firearm, they may be in violation of Federal Law. However, in the following situations an individual would not be possessing a firearm in violation of 922(q)(A):

1. The individual is licensed by the State or political subdivision to possess the firearm, and the license was issued after law enforcement officials verified that the individual is qualified to receive the license;
2. The firearm is unloaded and is contained within a locked container or a locked firearms rack that is on a motor vehicle;
3. The firearm is possessed by an individual for use in a school-approved program;
4. The individual or his/her employer is doing so in accordance with a contract between the individual and the school;
5. The individual is a law enforcement officer acting in their official capacity; or
6. The individual is crossing school grounds to reach a public or private way. Their firearm is unloaded, and they have permission from the school.

ATF realizes that not all persons who enter or exit an FFL's premises in such case may fall under one of the above-described statutory exemptions. Therefore, ATF advises that in those States where a permit is not needed, the FFL should ensure that prior to a purchaser leaving the business premise with a firearm that it is unloaded and placed in a locked container.

Federal Law

The Gun Control Act of 1968, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, provides in pertinent parts as follows:

18 U.S.C. 922(q)(1)

(q)(1) The Congress finds and declares that—

(A) crime, particularly crime involving drugs and guns, is a pervasive, nationwide problem;

(B) crime at the local level is exacerbated by the interstate movement of drugs, guns, and criminal gangs;

(C) firearms and ammunition move easily in interstate commerce and have been found in increasing numbers in and around schools, as documented in numerous hearings in both the Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate;

(D) in fact, even before the sale of a firearm, the gun, its component parts, ammunition, and the raw materials from which they are made have considerably moved in interstate commerce;

(E) while criminals freely move from State to State, ordinary citizens and foreign visitors may fear to travel to or through certain parts of the country due to concern about violent crime and gun violence, and parents may decline to send their children to school for the same reason;

(F) the occurrence of violent crime in school zones has resulted in a decline in the quality of education in our country;

(G) this decline in the quality of education has an adverse impact on interstate commerce and the foreign commerce of the United States;

(H) States, localities, and school systems find it almost impossible to handle gun-related crime by themselves—even States, localities, and school systems that have made strong efforts to prevent, detect, and punish gun-related crime find their efforts unavailing due in part to the failure or inability of other States or localities to take strong measures; and

(I) the Congress has the power, under the interstate commerce clause and other provisions of the Constitution, to enact measures to ensure the integrity and safety of the Nation's schools by enactment of this subsection.

(2)(A) It shall be unlawful for any individual knowingly to possess a firearm that has moved in or that otherwise affects interstate or foreign commerce at a place that the individual knows, or has reasonable cause to believe, is a school zone.

(B) Subparagraph (A) does not apply to the possession of a firearm—

(i) on private property not part of school grounds;

(ii) if the individual possessing the firearm is licensed to do so by the State in which the school zone is located or a political subdivision of the State, and the law of the State or political subdivision requires that, before an individual obtains such a license, the law enforcement authorities of the State or political subdivision verify that the individual is qualified under law to receive the license;

(iii) that is—

(I) not loaded; and

(II) in a locked container, or a locked firearms rack that is on a motor vehicle;

(iv) by an individual for use in a program approved by a school in the school zone;

(v) by an individual in accordance with a contract entered into between a school in the school zone and the individual or an employer of the individual;

(vi) by a law enforcement officer acting in his or her official capacity; or

(vii) that is unloaded and is possessed by an individual while traversing school premises for the purpose of gaining access to public or private lands open to hunting, if the entry on school premises is authorized by school authorities.

Administrator Recommendation of Expulsion Matrix

This matrix is a tool designed to help administrators decide when expulsion of a student is deemed mandatory, expected, or at administrators discretion.
