**STIPULATED MOTION TO  
AMEND BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

22 Plaintiffs Center for Biological Diversity, Sierra Club and Grand Canyon  
23 Wildlands Council; Federal Defendant United States Forest Service; and Intervenor-

1 Defendants the National Rifle Association of America (“NRA”), Safari Club  
2 International (“SCI”), and National Shooting Sports Foundation, Inc. (“NSSF”)  
3 (collectively “the Parties”) hereby respectfully request that the Court adopt the Parties’  
4 stipulation amending the Court-ordered briefing scheduling for pending motions.

5 On July 19, 2016, Plaintiffs, Federal Defendant, and Intervenor-Defendants  
6 (collectively “the Parties”) filed a Stipulated Motion to Set Briefing Schedule and  
7 Extend Page Limitations. *See* Dkt. 121. As part of this motion, the Parties stipulated to a  
8 briefing schedule on Federal Defendant’s and Intervenor-Defendants’ motions to  
9 dismiss and motion for judgment on the pleadings. *See id.* at 2. The Court granted the  
10 Parties’ motion on July 21, 2016. *See* Dkt. 122.

11 Pursuant to the Court-adopted briefing schedule, on August 12, 2016, Federal  
12 Defendant filed a motion to dismiss (Dkt. 123), pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil  
13 Procedure 12(b)(6). Also on August 12, 2016, Intervenor-Defendant NSSF filed a  
14 motion for judgment on the pleadings (Dkt. 124) pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil  
15 Procedure 12(c). On August 26, 2016, Intervenor-Defendants NRA and SCI filed a  
16 motion to dismiss (Dkt. 125) pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6).  
17 Plaintiffs’ consolidated response brief is due September 9, 2016; the Federal  
18 Defendant’s and NSSF’s reply briefs are due September 30, 2016; and the NRA’s and  
19 SCI’s reply brief is due October 14, 2016. *See* Dkt. 122 at 1.

20 Due to the competing litigation obligations, travel schedules, and the number of  
21 legal arguments that the Parties have raised and must respond to, the Parties have  
22 stipulated to the following amended briefing schedule:
