Fourth Street, Santa Ana, California, in the courtroom of the Honorable Judge
James V. Selna, Plaintiffs Dorothy McKay, Diana Kilgore, Phillip Willms, Fred
Kogen, David Weiss, and The CRPA Foundation (collectively, "Plaintiffs") will
and hereby do move for preliminary injunction pursuant to Rule 65(a) of the
Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

9 Plaintiffs will seek an order preliminarily enjoining Defendant Sheriff
