ORDER

This is a preliminary injunction appeal.

The motion of NRA Civil Rights Defense Fund (“NRACRDF”) to extend time to file its amicus curiae brief and the accompanying motion for leave to appear as amicus curiae is granted. NRACRDF’s motion for leave to file a brief amicus curiae is referred to the panel assigned to hear the merits of this appeal.

Within 7 days after the date of this order, the prospective amicus is ordered to file 7 copies of the brief in paper format, with a green cover, accompanied by certification (attached to the end of each copy of the brief) that the brief is identical

to the version submitted electronically. A sample certificate is available on the court's website, [www.ca9.uscourts.gov](http://www.ca9.uscourts.gov), at the Electronic Filing - ECF link.

The paper copies shall be printed from the PDF version of the brief created from the word processing application, not from PACER or Appellate ECF.

The motion of International Law Enforcement Educator & Trainers Association, et al., for leave to file a corrected brief of prospective amici curiae is granted. Within 7 days after the date of this order, prospective amici shall comply with the provisions of the December 10, 2012 order.

The request for certification of appellants' potential constitutional challenge to the State Attorney General shall be addressed separately.

The previously established briefing schedule remains in effect.
