
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pendency of this action is hereby issued, and the hearing on the OSC shall take place on January 13, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 20.

Petitioners' papers filed in support of the application herein shall constitute the moving papers on the OSC. Opposition and reply papers shall be filed in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure section 1005.

No later than 5 days prior to the hearing, the parties shall notify the Court of the time estimate for the hearing on the OSC.
