PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, that upon the Declarations of Andrew Lunetta dated May 29, 2014 and Michelle Goldberg-Cahn dated June 5, 2014, and the exhibits annexed thereto, Defendants' Statement Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 56.1 dated June 5, 2014, Defendants' Memorandum of Law in Support of Their Cross-Motion For Summary Judgment and in Opposition To Plaintiffs' Motion For a Preliminary Injunction, dated June 5, 2014, and upon the Amended Complaint and all prior papers and proceedings herein, the undersigned will move this Court before the Honorable Robert W.
