20	1. This is an action in the nature	of quo warranto brought pursuant to California			
21	Code of Civil Procedure section 803 to try the title of Defendant FRANK QUINTERO				
22	("Defendant QUINTERO") to the office of Councilmember of the City of Glendale ("the City").				
_23_	2. Section 803 of the Code of Civil Procedure authorizes an action in the nature of				
24	quo warranto against a person who usurps, intrudes into, or unlawfully holds or exercises any				
25	public office within the State of California.				
26	3. Defendant QUINTERO was appointed to the office of Councilmember by the				
27	Glendale City Council to fill a vacancy left on the Council following a City election in violation				
28	of the City's Charter.				

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1	4. On, California Attorney General Kamala D. Harris granted				
2	Relators, John Rando and Mariano A. Rodas' application for leave to sue Defendant QUINTERO				
3	in quo warranto in the name of the People of the State of California. A copy of the Attorney				
4	General's formal Leave to Sue is attached hereto as Exhibit A.				
5	PARTIES				
6	5. Plaintiff in this action is the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.				
7	Relators John Rando and Mariano A. Rodas are City residents and taxpayers.				
8	6. A Defendant in this action is FRANK QUINTERO. Defendant QUINTERO was				
9	appointed to the office of Councilmember by the Glendale City Council to fill a vacancy on the				
10	Council on or about April 23, 2013 within several days after his elected term as Councilmember				
11	had ended on or about April 15, 2013, due to his not seeking reelection in the City's most recent				
12	election.				
13	7. The other Defendant in this action is the City of Glendale, a charter city under				
14	Article 11, Section 3 of the Constitution of the State of California.				
15	JURISDICTION AND VENUE				
16	8. The Superior Court has jurisdiction over this action. Defendant QUINTERO is a				
17	sitting Councilmember of the City of Glendale, whose district falls within the boundaries of Los				
18	Angeles County.				
19	9. Venue is proper in this Court under Code of Civil Procedure Section 393(b)				
20	because the action is against a: public officer in the City of Glendale for an act done by him in				
21	virtue of his office, and under Code of Civil Procedure Section 395(a) because the cause of action				
22	arose in the City of Glendale and the defendant claims to reside in the City of Glendale.				
23	QUO WARRANTO				
24	10. Plaintiff incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 8, inclusive.				
25	11. Defendant QUINTERO was appointed to the office of Councilmember by the				
26	Glendale City Council to fill a vacancy on the City Council on or about April 23, 2013.				
27	12. Just several days before his appointment, on or about April 15, 2013, his elected				
28	term as Councilmember had ended due to his not seeking reelection in the City's most recent				

1	election.			
2	13. Article VI, Section 12 of the City's Charter entitled "Councilmembers holding			
3	other city offices" plainly provides that:			
4	No former councilmember shall hold any compensated city office or city employment until two (2) years after leaving the office of councilmember.			
5	employment until two (2) years after leaving the office of councilmember.			
6	14. Because Defendant QUINTERO was a "former councilmember" at the time of his			
7	April 23, 2013 appointment, his appointed position is one of a "compensated city office," and two			
8	years had not yet passed from his "leaving the office of councilmember" to the time of his			
9	appointment, Defendant QUINTERO holds the office of Councilmember of the City of Glendale			
10	in violation of Article VI, Section 12 of the City's Charter.			
11	PRAYER FOR RELIEF			
12	Therefore, THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA pray that this Court issue			
13	judgment against Defendant FRANK QUINTERO as follows:			
14	1. An order removing Defendant FRANK QUINTERO from the office of			
15	Councilmember of the City of Glendale;			
16	2. An order awarding Plaintiff its attorneys' fees pursuant to California Code of Civil			
17	Procedure § 1021.5 or otherwise;			
18	3. An order awarding Plaintiff its costs incurred in this suit pursuant to California			
19	Code of Civil Procedure § 809; and			
20	4. An order awarding Plaintiff such further and additional relief as the Court deems			
21	just and proper.
