**JOINT MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULING ORDER**

On May 9, 2016, the Court entered an Order [67] setting forth a schedule for discovery in this case. According to the schedule, all discovery is to be completed, and all discovery-related motions are to be filed, by December 9, 2016; the Order also sets a status conference for that day. To date, the parties have timely exchanged written discovery, documents, and expert reports, but require additional time to complete expert depositions. All such depositions are currently scheduled for December 8, 2016 (plaintiff's expert), and December 14-16, 2016 (defendants' experts). To accommodate these depositions, the parties now jointly request a modification of the existing schedule that extends the discovery period through December 23, 2016. No other deadline will be affected by this request, as the Court need not necessarily continue the December 9, 2016 status hearing; no party will suffer prejudice, as plaintiffs and defendants jointly make this request. A supporting memorandum and proposed order accompany this Joint Motion.
