DECLARATION OF CHAD CHEUNG

I, Chad Cheung, declare as follows:

1. I am a plaintiff in the above-entitled action. I make this declaration of my own personal knowledge and, if called as a witness, I could and would testify competently to the truth of the matters set forth herein.

2. I am a law-abiding adult who is not prohibited from owning firearms under the laws of the United States or the state of California. I have never been found by any law enforcement agency, any court, or any other government agency to be irresponsible, unsafe, or negligent with firearms in any manner.

3. I am a resident of the city of Los Angeles, California and the Captain of the Calguns.net Shooting Team.

4. I lawfully own and possess within my Los Angeles residence ammunition magazines with the capacity to accept more than ten rounds that are prohibited by section 46.30 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.

5. In accordance with state law, I lawfully possess these magazines while traveling to and from shooting ranges and shooting competitions outside Los Angeles.

6. As expressly authorized by state law, I also travel between my residence and locations outside California while possessing these magazines for lawful purposes, including participation

1 in shooting competitions.

2 7. Section 46.30 prohibits me from continuing to possess my lawfully-owned magazines
3 with the capacity to accept more than ten rounds in my home on or after November 19, 2015.

4 8. Section 46.30 prohibits me from continuing to possess my lawfully-owned magazines
5 with the capacity to accept more than ten rounds while traveling between my Los Angeles
6 residence and locations inside and outside California on or after November 19, 2015.

7 9. If I transfer my lawfully-owned magazines with the capacity to accept more than ten
8 rounds, or if I turn them into the Los Angeles Police Department for destruction, I will not be able
9 to reacquire them.

10 10. I fear arrest and criminal prosecution if I continue to possess my magazines with the
11 capacity to hold more than ten rounds in the city of Los Angeles on or after November 19, 2015.

13 I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the
14 forgoing is true and correct.




