The motion hearing is held. The Court states its tentative views that it is inclined to deny Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment (the "Plaintiff's Motion") and grant Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment on Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief (the "Defendant's Motion"). Counsel address the Court. On or before November 13, 2017, counsel shall each file a supplemental brief, not to exceed 4 pages, regarding the standard to be applied to the competing evidence submitted with respect to the fit between the challenged laws and the stated governmental interests. The supplemental brief shall address the following cases, *Jackson v. City and County of San Francisco*, 746 F.3d 953 (9th Cir. 2014), *Kachalsky v. County of Westchester*, 701 F.3d 81 (2d Cir. 2012) and *Woollard v. Gallagher*, 712 F.3d 865 (4th Cir. 2013), among others. The Court takes the Plaintiff's Motion, Defendant's Motion and Everytown for Gun Safety's Motion for Leave to File Amicus Curiae Brief in Support of Defendants UNDER SUBMISSION and a ruling will be issued.
