7 subds. (b)–(c), § 5476 subds. (d)–(e), § 5477 and, § 5473 subd. (b)(1) (“the challenged
8 regulations”) pending the trial of this action or further order of this court.

9 The Court reserves jurisdiction to modify or dissolve the injunction as may be
10 required by the interests of justice.


