Dear Ms. Dwyer:

Defendant-Appellant Xavier Becerra respectfully submits this citation of supplemental authority pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 28(j) and Circuit Rule 28-6. Following the close of briefing in this matter, the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts granted the government's motion for summary judgment in a case challenging Massachusetts's ban on the transfer or possession of assault weapons and large-capacity magazines under the Second Amendment. *Worman v. Healey*, ___ F. Supp. 3d __, No. 17-10107-WGY, 2018 WL 1663445 (D. Mass. Apr. 5, 2018). The district court held that large-capacity magazines fall outside the scope of the Second Amendment because they are "most useful in military service," and thus the ban on large-capacity magazines was constitutional at the first step of the court's Second Amendment analysis. *Id.* at *10 (citing *Kolbe v. Hogan*, 849 F.3d 114, 136 (4th Cir. 2017) (en banc), *cert. denied*, 138 S. Ct. 469 (2017)). This new authority is yet another case upholding the constitutionality of large-capacity magazine restrictions under the Second Amendment. *(See* Appellant's Opening Brief at 24-25, 27; Appellant's Reply Brief at 5 n.1.)
