jurisdiction of the trial court or (2) capable of accurate and ready determination by 1 2 resort to sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned." Fed. R. Evid. 3 201(b). A court shall take judicial notice of such a fact if requested by a party and 4 supplied with the necessary information. *Id.* 201(d). "A trial court may presume 5 that public records are authentic and trustworthy." Gilbrook v.
