**[PROPOSED] JUDGMENT**

18 The cross-motions for summary judgment filed by Defendant Xavier Becerra,  
19 in his official capacity as Attorney General of the State of California (Doc. 73), and  
20 Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Charyl Johnson, Michael Jones,  
21 Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis Martin, and the  
22 California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. (Doc. 77), respectively, came on for  
23 hearing before this Court on May 31, 2019. Deputy Attorneys General Peter H.  
24 Chang and John D. Echeverria appeared on behalf of Defendant Xavier Becerra, as  
25 Attorney General of the State of California. Sean Brady of Michel & Associates,  
26 P.C., appeared on behalf of all Plaintiffs. After considering the moving and  
27 opposing papers and evidence, and the arguments of counsel at the hearing, on

1 July 22, 2019, the Court issued an order granting Defendant Attorney General's  
2 motion for summary judgment and denying Plaintiffs' motion for summary  
3 judgment. (Doc. 108.)

4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Judgment is  
5 entered in favor of Defendant Xavier Becerra, as Attorney General of the State of  
6 California, and against Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Charyl Johnson,  
7 Michael Jones, Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis Martin,  
8 and the California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. Plaintiffs shall take nothing by  
9 way of their Third Amended Complaint from Defendant Xavier Becerra, as  
10 Attorney General of the State of California. Each and every claim and prayer for  
11 relief asserted in Plaintiffs' Third Amended Complaint is denied. Defendant is the  
12 prevailing party and shall be entitled to recover reasonable costs of suit.

13 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
