17 capacity as Health Officer of the County of Santa Clara, Laurie Smith, in her official capacity as  
18 Sheriff of the County of Santa Clara, and Jeff Rosen, in his official capacity as District Attorney  
19 for the County of Santa Clara:

20 Based upon the Petition for Writ of Mandate and/or Prohibition or Other Appropriate  
21 Relief; Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief filed in this action, you are ordered to


