- Defendants admit the allegations, except for the last sentence, contained in Paragraph No.

- 12. Defendants are unable to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph No. 44 of the plaintiff's complaint, for lack of knowledge, and leave plaintiff to his proof of same.
- 13. Defendants deny the allegations contained in Paragraph Nos. 48 and 49, as to their context, of Count I of the plaintiff's complaint.
- 14. As alleged in Paragraph No. 50, defendants reassert their responses to Paragraph Nos. 1 through 48.
- 15. Defendants are unable to admit or deny the allegations contained in Paragraph No. 51 of Count II of the plaintiff's complaint, for lack of knowledge, and leave plaintiff to his proof of same.

- 16. Defendants deny the allegations contained in Paragraph No. 52 of Count II of the plaintiff's complaint.
- 17. As alleged in Paragraph No. 53, defendants reassert their responses to Paragraph Nos. 1 through 51.
- 18. Defendants admit the allegations contained in Paragraph Nos. 54 and 55 of Count III of the plaintiff's complaint.
- 19. Defendants deny the allegations contained in Paragraph No.56 of Count III of the plaintiff's complaint.
- 20. As alleged in Paragraph No. 57, defendants reassert their responses to Paragraph Nos. 1 through 56.
- 21. Defendants deny the allegations contained in Paragraph No. 58 of Count IV of the plaintiff's complaint.
- 22. As alleged in Paragraph No. 59, defendants reassert their responses to Paragraph Nos. 1 through 57.
- 23. Defendants deny the allegations contained in Paragraph No. 60 of Count V of the plaintiff's complaint.
