(no summons has been issued; I submitted a request today) and actually effectuate service, which I can begin as soon as I receive the issuance of summons.

- 4. CR 3.110(e) permits the Court, "on its own motion or on the application of a party, may extend or otherwise modify the times provided in" subdivision (b).
- 5. On February 2, 2020 I filed a first request on behalf of plaintiff, and on February 10, 2020 the Court granted my request, to extend the deadline for service of this case until May 13, 2020. On May 12, 2020, I submitted for filing a second such request. However, due to clerk error (acknowledged by the Court), the Clerk's Office rejected that filing (twice, on May 28, 2020 and June 2, 2020). I therefore resubmitted the request on May 30, 2020. On June 8, 2020, the Court plaintiff's second request.
- 6. Since that time, I continued to work assiduously to secure associate counsel. Those efforts were slowed by the global covid19 pandemic. This association is now all but finalized, enabling me to begin service. However, as no summons has yet issued in this case, I first need to obtain a summons.
- 7. Thereafter, I need to serve 14 separate defendants. I have already assembled a service list. But I cannot be sure until I attempt service on each defendant whether my service list is fully current and effective.
- 8. In light of the foregoing, plaintiff respectfully requests a further extension for time for service of the summons and complaint on the named defendants in this case until November 20, 2020.
 - 9. A proposed order accompanies this request.
