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**DECLARATION OF RITA BOSWORTH**

I, Rita Bosworth, am not a party in the above-title action. I am over the age of 18, have personal knowledge of the facts and events referred to in this Declaration, and am competent to testify to the matters stated below.

1. On April 4, 2022, I emailed Richard Bailey at the email address provided to me by his former counsel. In the email, I asked if he wished to stipulate to dismiss the case since he no longer had counsel. I included a proposed stipulation for him to review, and I asked him to let me know whether he agreed to the stipulation.

2. On April 4, 2022, after I sent Mr. Bailey the email, I called and spoke to him on his cell phone. I informed him that his counsel had withdrawn from representing him, and I asked him if he would like to stipulate to dismiss the case. Mr. Bailey asked to have some time to consider his options and asked me to email him the stipulation, which I informed him I had already done. I informed Mr. Bailey that his discovery responses were overdue, and I requested that he send me his responses as soon as possible if he did not want to agree to dismiss the case. Mr. Bailey told me he would get back to me later that week.

3. On April 11, 2022, I emailed Mr. Bailey for the second time, re-sending him the stipulation and asking him for a response. He has not responded to any of my emails.

4. On April 11, 2022, I called Mr. Bailey on his cell phone. He did not pick up the phone, and I left him a voicemail message. He has not responded to my call.
