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## **REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE**

Defendants Attorney General Xavier Becerra and Bureau of Firearms Director Martin Horan<sup>1</sup> (Defendants) respectfully request that this Court take judicial notice, pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201, of the following materials: (1) Senate Bill 1446, Cal. Stats. 2016, ch. 58; (2) California Ballot Pamphlet (Firearms. Ammunition Sales. Initiative Statute. California Proposition 63 (2016)); and (3) Cal. Secretary of State, Supplement to the Statement of Vote, Statewide Summary by County for Ballot Measures (Nov. 8, 2016).

8 Federal Rule of Evidence 201(b) provides that "[t]he court may judicially notice a fact that 9 is not subject to reasonable dispute because it: (1) is generally known within the trial court's 10 territorial jurisdiction; or (2) can be accurately and readily determined from sources whose 11 accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned." Fed. R. Evid. 201(b). The Court may take judicial 12 notice of the legislative history of a statute. See Anderson v. Holder, 673 F.3d 1089, 1094 n.1 13 (9th Cir. 2012) (taking notice of excerpts of a Senate Report). It is also appropriate for the Court 14 to take judicial notice of court filings in the same case and "other matters of public record." 15 Reyna v. Pasta Bella, LLC v. Visa USA, Inc., 442 F.3d 741, 746 n.6 (9th Cir. 1996); see also Lee 16 v. City of Los Angeles, 250 F.3d 668, 688 (9th Cir. 2001). The Court may also take judicial notice 17 of election results. See Badillo v. City of Stockton, 956 F.2d 884, 887 n.1 (9th Cir.), as amended 18 (9th Cir. 1992). Sufficient notice of matters subject to judicial notice is provided by lodging a 19 copy of the relevant documents and records with the Court. Accordingly, Defendants respectfully 20 request that this Court take judicial notice of the exhibits to the accompanying declaration of 21 counsel. 22 23 24
