DECLARATION OF VIRGINIA DUNCAN

I. I, Virginia Duncan, am a plaintiff in the above-entitled action. I make
 this declaration of my own personal knowledge and, if called as a witness, I could
 and would testify competently to the truth of the matters set forth herein.

5 2. I am a law-abiding adult who is not prohibited from owning firearms
6 under the laws of the United States of America or the state of California. I have
7 never been found by any law enforcement agency, any court, or any other
8 government agency to be irresponsible, unsafe, or negligent with firearms in any
9 manner.

3. 10 I am currently the lead Plaintiff in an individual capacity in the matter of Duncan v. Bonta, a case which challenges California's magazine capacity 11 restrictions. My attorneys have explained to me that under the newly enacted 12 California Code of Civil Procedure section 1021.11, if we are not successful in all 13 our claims in Duncan v. Bonta, it is possible that I could be found to be liable 14 (together with my attorneys and the other Plaintiffs) for the State's attorney's fees 15 and costs because Section 1021.11 is not limited to cases filed after its effective 16 date. 17

I am now deeply concerned I will be found liable for the State's legal
expenses in *Duncan v. Bonta* and don't know whether I should remain in that
litigation as a Plaintiff. I certainly will not be participating in any future lawsuits
while section 1021.11 is in effect if this lawsuit fails to stop it. The State has taken
away my right to petition the courts, at least when it comes to my firearm rights.
I declare under penalty of perjury of the laws of the State of California and

the United States that the foregoing is true and correct.
