**[PROPOSED] ORDER FOR
STIPULATION AND JOINT MOTION
TO EXTEND TIME TO RESPOND TO
THE COMPLAINT BY MORE THAN
30 DAYS & REQUEST FOR
SCHEDULING ORDER**

Before the Court is the Stipulation and Joint Motion to Extend Time to Respond to the Complaint by More Than 30 Days & Request For Scheduling Order. Having reviewed the motion, and good cause appearing, the Court hereby GRANTS the motion and orders as follows:

1. Plaintiffs are to file and serve the First Amended Complaint on or before November 11, 2022;
2. Plaintiffs are to file and serve any motion for preliminary injunction on or before November 15, 2022;
3. Stipulating Defendants are to file and serve any opposition to the

1 motion for preliminary injunction on or before December 9, 2022;

2 4. Plaintiffs are to file and serve any reply to the opposition to the motion
3 for preliminary injunction on or before December 16, 2022;

4 5. The hearing on Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction is set for
5 December 30, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.

6 6. The Stipulating Defendants' time to answer, move to dismiss, or
7 otherwise respond to the First Amended Complaint shall be extended until sixty
8 (60) days after the hearing on Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction, or 30
9 days after the ruling on the motion for preliminary injunction is issued, whichever
10 is later.
