Glendale Municipal Code § 9.25.050, subd. (A) against any individuals with

1 concealed handgun licenses issued pursuant to California Penal Code sections
2 26150 or 26155.

3 The court reserves jurisdiction to modify this injunction as the ends of justice
4 may require.
