- 1. The Court grants Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction.
- 2. Defendant Attorney General Robert Bonta, and his officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and those persons in active concert or participation with him, and those duly sworn state peace officers and federal law enforcement officers who gain knowledge of this injunction order or know the existence of this injunction order are enjoined from implementing or enforcing California Penal Code sections 31900 through 32110, or from otherwise preventing the retail sale of all handguns that are not listed on the Roster of firearms approved for sale as of the date of entry of this order.
- 3. Defendant Bonta shall provide, by personal service or otherwise, actual notice of this order to all law enforcement personnel who are responsible for implementing or enforcing the enjoined statutes. The government shall file a declaration establishing proof of such notice.
- 4. Defendant Bonta shall provide, by personal service or otherwise, actual notice of this order to all licensed California firearms dealers informing them they may now use the state's DROS entry system in such manner consistent with this order preliminarily enjoining sections 31900 through 32110, to facilitate the retail purchase of firearms no longer barred from retail sale due to this order.
