The parties shall each file a letter brief discussing: (1) whether the appellees' voluntary cessation renders this case moot under *Rosebrock v. Mathis*, 745 F.3d 963, 972 (9th Cir. 2014) and (2) whether we should depart from our prior practice of "vacat[ing] the judgment of the district court and remand[ing] [the] case to the district court for further proceedings pursuant to" the Supreme Court's decision in *New York State Rifle & Pistol Assn., Inc. v. Bruen*, 142 S. Ct. 2111 (2022). *Young v. Hawaii*, 45 F.4th 1087, 1089 (9th Cir. 2022) (en banc); *see also Duncan v. Bonta*, 49 F.4th 1228, 1231 (9th Cir. 2022) (en banc); *McDougall v. Cnty. of Ventura*, 38 F.4th 1162 (9th Cir. 2022) (en banc); *Jones v. Bonta*, 47 F.4th 1124, 1125 (9th Cir. 2022); *Rupp v. Bonta*, No. 19-56004, 2022 WL 2382319, at *1 (9th Cir. June 28, 2022); *Mitchell v. Atkins*, No. 20-35827, 2022 WL 17420766, at *1

(9th Cir. Dec. 2, 2022).

Each party's brief shall not exceed 15 pages and shall be due on or before January 25, 2023.
