DECLARATION OF CHRIS MOORE

I, CHRIS MOORE, being first duly sworn upon oath, state the following:


1. I make this Declaration in support of the actions being taking in this matter to challenge 720 ILCS 5/24-1.9, et seq. ("Illinois' Firearms Ban Act");
2. I have personal knowledge of the allegations contained in this Declaration and, if called to testify at a hearing and/or trial in this matter, will competently testify to the allegations contained in this Declaration;
3. I am over 21 years of age;
4. I am a citizen and resident of the State of Illinois, the United States of America and this judicial district;
5. I am a law-abiding individual and legally eligible under state and federal laws to acquire, maintain, modify, possess, purchase, repair, sell, supply and/or transfer to others, transport and/or travel freely with, and/or use firearms, firearms attachments and/or firearms parts;
6. I am a licensed physician and live with my wife and son and want my wife to be able to use the AR-15 for the self defense of her family and herself, because she is of shorter stature with a weaker grip and the AR-15 is easier, and, thus, safer for her to use;

7. Because of the passage of Illinois' Firearms Ban, I will not be able to provide my wife with the firearms I believe are best suited to her needs and will not be able to repair any of the firearms with parts now banned by Illinois' Firearms Ban Act;

8. I have no plain, speedy and adequate remedy at law to fully redress the continued violation of our civil and constitutional rights caused by Illinois' Firearms Ban Act; and
