**Proceedings: [Minutes of] Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. No. 13)  
(Held and Completed)**

Case called and appearances made. The Court discussed with the parties whether Plaintiffs' counsel's declarations filed in support of the motion for preliminary injunction raise concerns regarding Rule 3.7 of the California Rules of Professional Conduct. No party having raised the Rule 3.7 issue, the Court proceeded with the merits of the pending motion as reflected on the record. After hearing arguments from the parties, the Court took the motion under submission.

As reflected on the record, the Court orders the parties to meet and confer to identify the specific areas in dispute as to which Plaintiffs contend their members seek to carry and cannot constitutionally be prohibited from carrying firearms, as well as the locations that the parties agree are "sensitive areas" where firearms may be prohibited and any areas where Defendants concede that Plaintiffs' members cannot constitutionally be precluded from carrying firearms.
