22	DECLARATION OF FRANK FEDERAU					
23	I, Frank Federau, declare as follows:					
24	1. I am an adult resident of the County of Santa Cruz, California, and a named					
25	plaintiff in this matter. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this declaration, and if					
26	called as a witness, could competently testify thereto. This declaration is executed in support of					
27	Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment.

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2. I am not prohibited from possessing or acquiring firearms under State or federal

3 3. I am a member of organization plaintiffs California Gun Rights Foundation 4 (formerly named "The Calguns Foundation"), Firearms Policy Coalition, FPC Action Foundation 5 (formerly named "Firearms Policy Foundation"), and Second Amendment Foundation. I am also 6 employed by plaintiff Firearms Policy Coalition.

7 4. I lawfully acquired a firearm magazine which holds ten (10) rounds of .458 SOCOM ammunition for a rifle chambered in that caliber. However, that magazine is also capable of holding over ten rounds of 5.56 x 45mm ammunition, and therefore, the State bans it as a "large-capacity" magazine.

5. In addition to maintaining possession of the "large-capacity" magazine that I already own and possess, I desire and intend to acquire more magazines capable of holding more than ten rounds of ammunition, and would, but for the State's laws challenged in this case and its enforcement of them.

6. Removing from the State or selling the magazine already in my possession outside of the State would adversely affect my right to keep and bear arms for self-defense and other lawful purposes.

7. As an ordinary, peaceable citizen, I do not qualify for any exception to the State's prohibition on the possession of "large-capacity" magazines.

8. Unless the enforcement of the State's "large-capacity" magazine ban laws is declared unconstitutional and enjoined, I will suffer a physical deprivation of property that is both independently valuable and a necessary part of a functional firearm.
