AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN COMMERFORD

I, John Commerford, being duly sworn, depose and state:

- 1. I am over the age of twenty-one years and fully competent to testify herein and swear that all of the facts and statements herein contained are true and correct and that, except as expressly noted otherwise, I have personal knowledge of the same.
- 2. I am the Chief of Operations of the NRA-Institute for Legislative Action (NRA-ILA) and Chairman of the NRA Victory Fund. In these roles, I participate in legislative affairs, direct political fundraising, and engage with a broad universe of NRA donors, grassroots volunteers, elected officials, and other supporters.
- 3. I have more than 14 years of experience with the NRA (and eight years of experience, collectively, with a non-profit sport shooting association and firearms distribution

company). I am familiar with the perception of the NRA and its Second Amendment advocacy among the Association's many constituents.

- 4. NRA-ILA is the "lobbying" arm of the NRA. Established in 1975, NRA-ILA is committed to preserving the right of all law-abiding individuals to purchase, possess and use firearms as guaranteed by the Second Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. NRA-ILA also celebrates the freedoms of speech and association through political advocacy.
- 5. Beginning in the summer of 2018, a then-candidate for the office of New York Attorney General (NYAG), Letitia James, made a series of highly publicized statements vowing, if elected, to investigate the NRA. She called the NRA a "organ of deadly propaganda," a "criminal enterprise" and a "terrorist organization." These statements generated a wave of negative publicity about the NRA.
- 6. As if to establish herself as an anti-NRA warrior, James, in early 2018, joined New York government officials to condemn a fundraising event benefitting the NRA Foundation.³ applauded retailers for stopping the sale of certain types of firearms and magazines,⁴ and celebrated banks that cut financial ties to firearms companies.⁵

7. James has used social media to assail "NRA-backed politicians" and tout her willingness to "take on the NRA, gun manufacturers, retailers & banks that fund these weapons of death [firearms]." Most obvious to me as a political advocate is that James uses her "anti-NRA" message as a campaign platform.

- 8. In September 2018, U.S. Rep. Maxine Waters (D-CA) taped an audio recording endorsing the James candidacy for NYAG and pointed to her efforts to "stand up to the NRA." Under the banner of "big endorsement news," James disseminated a tweet quoting the congresswoman.⁸
- 9. As a *candidate* for NYAG, James should not have had factual evidence of misconduct sufficient to warrant dissolution, or evidence that the Association was a "criminal enterprise." In fact, she would not have possessed evidence that the NRA was not in compliance with the laws governing nonprofit organizations in New York.
- 10. Upon being elected NYAG, James made good on her campaign promise to investigate the NRA. On April 27, 2019, her office notified the NRA that it launched an investigation into the organization and issued document preservation notices to the NRA and some of its affiliates. This generated a burst of negative media coverage.⁹

11. On August 5, 2020, James issued a media advisory trumpeting a "major national announcement." The following day, on August 6, 2020, she held a national press conference where she announced the filing of a lawsuit to dissolve the NRA – to shut us down forever. 11

- 12. Simultaneously, the NYAG's office escalated its public relations campaign featuring media statements, tweets and other public communications. This resulted in widespread negative media attention for the Association. Her lawsuit generated coverage from *The Wall Street Journal, The New York Times, The Washington Post, The New York Daily News*, CNN, and MSNBC, to name just a few. ¹²
- 13. The same day she announced her "dissolution" lawsuit, Attorney General James sent out a fundraising appeal celebrating her efforts to confront "abuses of trust and unchecked greed run amok."¹³
- 14. As someone experienced in politics and campaigns, I believe this publicity was engineered to create reputational harm for the NRA and help the NYAG politically. Many editorial writers concluded the same.¹⁴

15. Later that year, in December 2020, James proudly touted her pursuit of the NRA in her "2020 Year In Review." Under the banner of "Stopping Self-Dealing and Fraud at the NRA," the report features colorful pictures, TV screen shots, and front-page images from national newspapers – all chronicling the NYAG's campaign against the NRA.¹⁵

- On October 29, 2021, James announced her campaign for governor with a launch 16. video that touted her work to "eliminate the NRA." 16
- 17. The NYAG's public relations onslaught harmed the NRA by creating a "cloud" over its future and negatively impacted its relationships with donors.
- For example, gross revenues for the NRA declined dramatically since the NYAG 18. expanded her messaging campaign against the NRA. Since 2018, approximate revenues are as follows:

19. This decline is due, in part, to the sustained negative publicity generated by the NYAG and her vow to "eliminate the NRA."

- 20. This has put the NRA in a defensive fundraising posture. A decline in revenue is a factor in the <u>reduction of certain programs</u>, <u>declining political expenditures</u>, and a <u>reduction in the total number of NRA-ILA personnel</u>.
- 21. The NRA was able to instill a measure of confidence in its donors and supporters when the NYAG's dissolution claims were struck down in March 2022. However, this was followed by the NYAG filing an amended complaint on May 2, 2022, which seeks the appointment of an independent compliance monitor to oversee the NRA's management of its assets.²¹
- 22. The invective against the NRA continued to be used by James as she neared her 2022 reelection for NYAG. At that time, she again used social media to admonish the NRA for trying to "evade the law and avoid the consequences of their actions." 22
- 23. I know from my significant contact with members, donors and supporters that the appointment of a compliance monitor would inflict further reputational and financial harm to the NRA creating a stigma around the Association and casting doubt on its ability to effectively advocate for its mission.
