MOTION OF DR. JAVIER HERRERA FOR PAPER COPIES OF APPENDIX TO BE ACCEPTED AS FILED

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MOTION

Amicus curiae Dr. Javier Herrera respectfully asks the Court to accept as filed paper copies of the statutory appendix to his amicus brief. On April 17, 2023, the clerk's office received paper copies of Dr. Herrera's brief and statutory appendix. Upon receiving the paper copies, the clerk's office informed Dr. Herrera's counsel that the Court ordinarily accepts briefs printed in portrait style only, and the front matter in the statutory appendix is printed in landscape style. The clerk's office instructed Dr. Herrera that he could file a motion to have the brief accepted as-printed.

Dr. Herrera respectfully moves the Court to accept paper copies of the statutory appendix. The statutory appendix is a compilation of historical statutes that are relevant to the constitutionality of the firearms laws at issue in this appeal. It is materially the same as the statutory appendix filed in Dr. Herrera's related case in support of his pending preliminary injunction motion. See Herrera v. Raoul, No. 1:23-cv-00532 (N.D. Ill.) (Jenkins, J.), ECF 63-1. The historical appendix includes over 400 pages of primary source material relating to firearms regulation that is central to resolving legal questions under the Supreme Court's Second Amendment framework announced in New York State Rifle & Pistol Association v. Bruen, 142 S. Ct. 2111 (2022). Each page of primary source material in Dr. Herrera's appendix is printed in portrait style. See App.74-App.559. The only pages printed in landscape style are the front matter, which contains condensed excerpts of that primary source material. See App.2-App.73.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Dr. Herrera respectfully asks the Court to accept paper copies of the amicus brief appendix as filed.
