[PROPOSED] JUDGMENT

1 The motions for summary judgment filed by Defendant Rob Bonta, in his
2 official capacity as Attorney General of the State of California (Dkt. ____), and
3 Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Charyl Johnson, Michael Jones,
4 Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis Martin, and the
5 California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. (Dkt. ____), respectively, came on for
6 hearing before this Court on July 28, 2023. Deputy Attorneys General John D.
7 Echeverria, Anna Ferrari, and Christina R.B. López appeared on behalf of
8 Defendant Rob Bonta, as Attorney General of the State of California. Sean Brady
9 of Michel & Associates, P.C., appeared on behalf of all Plaintiffs. After
10 considering the moving and opposing papers and evidence, and the arguments of
11 counsel at the hearing, the Court issued an order granting Defendant Attorney
12 General's motion for summary judgment and denying Plaintiffs' motion for
13 summary judgment. (Dkt. ____.)

14 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED
15 that Judgment is entered in favor of Defendant Rob Bonta, as Attorney General of
16 the State of California, and against Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Charyl
17 Johnson, Michael Jones, Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis
18 Martin, and the California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. Plaintiffs shall take
19 nothing by way of their Third Amended Complaint from Defendant Rob Bonta, as
20 Attorney General of the State of California. Each and every claim and prayer for
21 relief asserted in Plaintiffs' Third Amended Complaint is denied. Defendant is the
22 prevailing party and shall be entitled to recover reasonable costs of suit. Defendant
23 may submit a "Bill of Costs" and an "Application to the Clerk to Tax Costs" to
24 recover any eligible litigation costs in this action. *See* C.D. Cal. R. 54-2, 54-2.1.
